

# BRIDGES TOWEL

Wool**



*Reminiscent of bridges crossing over rivers, the pattern is a combination of stockinette and ribbing.*

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## Sizes

8" x 14"

## Gauge

5 sts = 1" in pattern

## Materials & Notions

Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn - 95 yds

Shown in Lily Sugar'n Cream Naturals -  
*Chocolate Ombre* and Knit Picks Simply

Cotton Worsted - *Golden Heather*

US 7 (4.5 mm) needles

Tapestry Needle

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## Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

st(s) = stitch(es)

Cast on 38 sts (or any increment of 5+3).  
Knit 4 rows

**Row 1:** knit all

**Row 2:** purl all

**Row 3:** knit all

**Row 4:** purl all

**Row 5:** p3, \*k2, p3\* to end

**Row 6:** k3, \*p2, k3\* to end

**Row 7:** p3, \*k2, p3\* to end

**Row 8:** k3, \*p2, k3\* to end

**Row 9:** knit all

**Row 10:** purl all

**Row 11:** knit all

**Row 12:** purl all

Repeat rows 5-12 for until cloth measures  
13.25" or 10 repeats.

Knit 5 rows.

Bind off and weave in ends.
