

# MELDED SCARF

*The Melded Scarf is what happens when two colors meet in the middle and come together to make a cosy and bold striped scarf. Worked in 1x1 rib the scarf is reversible, and looks great on anyone. The Melded Scarf is also a great showcase for variegated and gradient yarns.*

*I originally designed this pattern for **Foster Care to Success's Red Scarf Project** which sends red scarves to college-bound foster youth for Valentine's Day.*

## Sizes

5.5"x 60" (74")

The Red Scarf Project requests scarfs that are 5-8" wide and 60" long, which is the first size listed. If you're making the scarf for something else and want to use every last bit of yarn, work the longer 74" scarf. Or, of course, you can make a scarf as long as you want.

## Gauge

7 sts/5 rows = 1" in 1x1 rib (unstretched)

## Materials & Notions

Worsted Weight Yarn in 2 colors

191 (210) yds of Color A

191 (210) yds of Color B

Scarf shown in Patons Classic Wool Worsted *Bright Red* and *Mercury*

US 7 (4.5mm) needles

## Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

sl1 wyif = slip 1 stitch purl-wise with yarn held in front of stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

## The Pattern

With Color A, cast on 38 sts using the long-tail cast on.

**Rows 1-16:** \*k1, p1\* until 1 st remains, sl1 wyif

### Stripe Pattern A

**Rows 1-2:** With Color B, \*k1, p1\* until 1 st remains, sl1 wyif

**Row 3-6:** With Color A, \*k1,p1\* until 1 st remains, sl1wyif

Work Stripe Pattern A 28 (32) times **OR** until the scarf is half the finished length you want. Then work Stripe Pattern B 28 (32) times **OR** the same number as Stripe Pattern A.

### Stripe Pattern B

**Rows 1-4:** With Color B, \*k1, p1\* until 1 st remains, sl1 wyif

**Rows 5-6:** With Color A, \*k1, p1\* until 1 st remains, sl1wyif

With Color B, work 17 rows in the established pattern. Bind off with the sewn bind off. Weave in ends and block.
