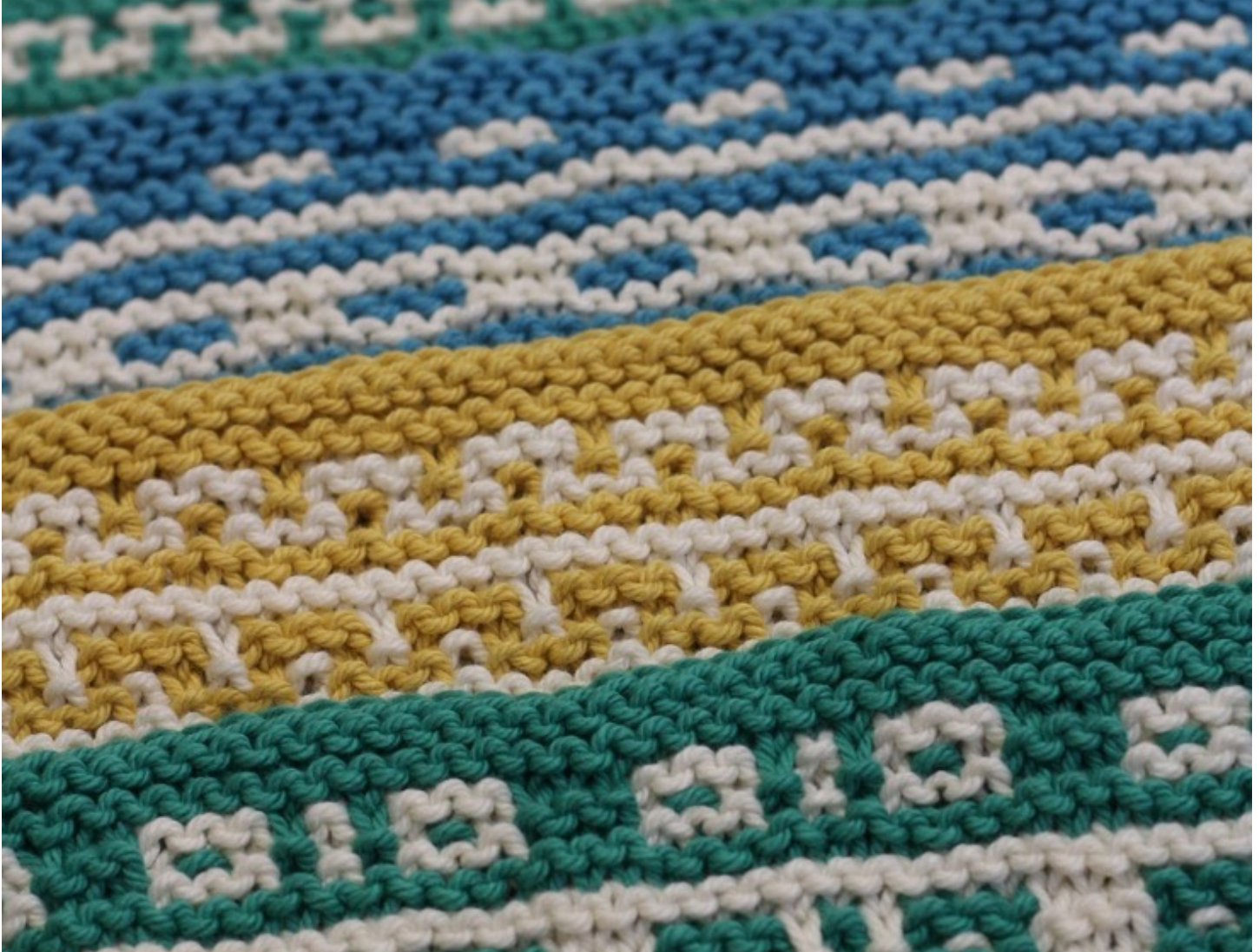

Mosaic Sisters

Colorful and geometric, the Mosaic Sisters are textured mosaic knit cloths perfect for the kitchen or the bathroom. Each cloth is made with garter stitch and slipped stitches that are simple to knit, but create complex patterns. All of the sisters can be made as a kitchen towel, washcloth, or coaster. Make a full set in 2 colors or mix and match.

Sizes

Kitchen Towel: 8.5" x 14"

Washcloth: 8.5" x 8"

Coaster: 4.25" x 4"

Gauge

5 stitches = 1" in pattern

Materials & Notions

Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn

Shown in Knit Picks Dishie - *Swan, Azure, Crème Brulee, and Tranquil*

Kitchen Towel: 37g / 70 yds each color

Washcloth: 20g / 39 yds each color

Coaster: 7g / 14 yds each color

US 6 (4mm) needles

Abbreviations

k = knit

sl = slip stitch purl-wise

wyib = with yarn in back

wyif = with yarn in front

C1 (2, 3, 4) = Color 1 (2, 3, 4)

st(s) = stitch(es)

RS = Right Side, front of cloth

WS = Wrong Side, back of cloth

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The Decrease Bind Off

I learned about the decrease bind off fairly recently and it's become one of my favorite ways to cast off. It's stretchy, easy, looks nice, and pairs well with the long-tail cast on. Plus, it can be worked with knits or purls. Here's how to do it:

p1, *slip stitch back to left needle, p2tog*, repeat between * * until all stitches are bound off

How much yarn do I need to knit:

3 kitchen towels: 210g main color, and 37g each contrast color

3 washcloths: 60g of main color, 20g each contrast color

1 kitchen towel & 1 washcloth: 57g of main color and contrast color

1 kitchen towel, 1 washcloth, 1 coaster: 68g main color and contrast color



Oldest Sister

For Kitchen Towel: With C1, cast on 45 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 5 rows. Work 6 full repeats, then work Rows 1-18. Knit 4 more rows with C2 and bind off.

For Washcloth: With C1, cast on 45 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 3 rows. Work 3 full repeats, then work Rows 1-18. Knit 2 more rows with C2 and bind off.

For Coaster: With C1, cast on 21 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 3 rows. Work 2.5 repeats total, ending on Row 8. Knit 2 more rows with C2 and bind off.

Repeat

Row 1: With C2, *k3, sl3 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib*, repeat section between * * until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3wyib, k3

Row 2: *k3, sl3 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif* until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3 wyif, k3

Row 3: With C1, *sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k1* to last 9 sts, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib

Row 4: *sl1, k1, sl1 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k1*, repeat to last 9 sts, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif

Row 5: With C2, *k3, sl3 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib*, repeat section between * until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3wyib, k3

Row 6: *k3, sl3 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif* until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3 wyif, k3

Row 7 & 8: With C1, knit all

Row 9 & 10: With C2, knit all

Row 11: With C1, *k3, sl3 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib*, repeat section between * until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3 wyib, k3

Row 12: *k3, sl3 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif* until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3 wyif, k3

Row 13: With C2, *sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k1* to last 9 sts, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1wyib

Row 14: *sl1, k1, sl1 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k1*, repeat to last 9 sts, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif

Row 15: With C1, *k3, sl3 wyib, k3, sl1 wyib, k1, sl1 wyib*, repeat section between * until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3 wyib, k3

Row 16: *k3, sl3 wyif, k3, sl1 wyif, k1, sl1 wyif* until there are 9 sts left, k3, sl3 wyif, k3

Row 17 & 18: With C2, knit all

Row 19 & 20: With C1, knit all

Middle Sister

For Kitchen Towel: With C1, cast on 45 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 5 rows. Work 5 full repeats, then work Rows 1-14. Knit 4 more rows with C3 and bind off.

For Washcloth: With C1, cast on 45 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 3 rows. Work 3 full repeats, then work Rows 1-14. Knit 2 more rows with C3 and bind off.

For Coaster: With C1, cast on 21 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 3 rows. Work 1 full repeat, then work Rows 1-14. Knit 2 more rows with C3 and bind off.

Repeat

Row 1: With C3, *k3, sl3 wyib*, repeat section between * * until 3 sts remain, k3

Row 2: *k3, sl3 wyif* to last 3 sts , k3

Row 3 & 4: With C1, knit all

Row 5 & 6: With C3, knit all

Row 7 & 8: With C1, knit all

Row 9 & 10: With C3, knit all

Row 11: With C1, *sl3 wyib, k3* to last 3 sts, sl3

Row 12: *sl 3 wyif, k3* to last 3 sts, sl3

Row 13 & 14: With C3, knit all

Row 15 & 16: With C1, knit all

Row 17 & 18: With C3, knit all

Row 19 & 20: With C1, knit all

Youngest Sister

For Kitchen Towel: With C1, cast on 45 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 5 rows. Work 5 full repeats, then work Rows 1-18. Knit 4 more rows with C4 and bind off.

For Washcloth: With C1, cast on 45 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 3 rows. Work 3 full repeats, then work Rows 1-18. Knit 4 more rows with C4 and bind off.

For Coaster: With C1, cast on 21 sts using the long-tail cast on. Knit 3 rows. Work 1 repeat, then rows 1-18. Knit 2 more rows with C4 and bind off.

Repeat

Row 1: With C4, *k2, sl1 wyib, k1* repeat between * * until 1 st remains, k1

Row 2: k1, *k1, sl1 wyif, k2*

Row 3: With C1, *k1, sl1 wyib* until 1 st remains, k1

Row 4: *k1, sl1 wyif* until 1 sts remains, k1

Row 5: With C4, *sl1 wyib, k3* until 1 sts remains, sl1

Row 6: sl1, *k3, sl1 wyif* to end

Row 7 & 8: With C1, k all sts

Row 9 & 10: With C4, knit all sts

Row 11: With C1, *sl1 wyib, k3* until 1 st remains, sl1

Row 12: sl1, *k3, sl1 wyif* to end of row

Row 13: With C4, *k1, sl1 wyib* until 1 st remains, k1

Row 14: k1, *sl1 wyif, k1*

Row 15: With C1 *k2, sl1 wyib, k1*, k1

Row 16: k1, *k1, sl1 wyif, k2*

Row 17 & 18: With C4, k all sts

Row 19 & 20: With C1, k all sts
