Waffle Time Washcloth

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The Waffle Time Washcloth is a quick knit with a stitch pattern that looks great on both sides. At 7" square, it's just the right size too. Make one as a gift for a friend or keep it for yourself.

Sizes

7" x 7" (17.78 x 17.78 cm)

Gauge

5 sts = 1" (2.54 cm) in waffle stitch pattern

Materials & Notions

55 yds (50.3 m) worsted weight cotton yarn

Shown in Peaches & Creme Solids

- Bright Orange and Burgundy

US 6 (4 mm) needles

Tapestry needle

Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

st(s) = stitch(es)



The Pattern

Cast on 40 sts with the long-tail cast on.

Note: If you use a different cast on, you'll need to knit 6 rows before beginning the stitch pattern.

Knit 5 rows before beginning the waffle stitch pattern below.

Row 1: k3, *p1, k2* until 4 sts remain, p1, k3

Row 2: k3, *k1, p2* until 4 sts remain, k4

Row 3: k3, *p1, k2* until 4 sts remain, p1, k3

Row 4: knit all sts

Repeat stitch pattern 11 times total.

Knit 4 rows.

Bind off with the p2tog decrease bind off, cut yarn, and weave in ends.

p2tog decrease bind off:

p2tog, slip stitch back to left needle, repeat instructions between * * until all stitches are bound off.

Note:

This pattern would also make a great kitchen towel or scarf. Repeat the stitch pattern until the work is .5" (1.27 cm) shorter than you want, then work the garter border.
